- I. Welcome, Sign in, Anita Brown-Sobeck, President
- II. Guest speaker: Jason Shutt, Bainbridge Island School Supporters (BIPSS)
Jason Shutt is co-chairing the campaign in support of the BISD Completion & Essential Renovations levy that will be on the February 12 ballot. Jason shared some details about what the levy would pay for, if approved. He also said that BIPSS request volunteers to help promote the levy, including sign wavers at the ferry dock. There was discussion regarding the school district's plan and priorities concerning the BHS Commons conversion to an auditorium.
- III. The minutes of the December 6, 2018 meeting were voted on and approved.
- IV. Tricia Corsetti, Principal, shared additional information about what the upcoming levy would help fund. Annie Grattan, EHHS Teacher, said that students and staff are getting back to the routine after the holiday break. She confirmed that she and Denise are interested in PTSO funding for three programable robots/rovers and the Texas Instruments calculators that are used for programing these. The price is \$908, and PTSO will use funds to pay for these from the STEM donation that PTSO is anticipating receiving from a local business. Trish said that EHHS finals will be during the week of 1/7-1/11, and the days of 1/16-1/18 will be used by EHHS students for student led conferences with EHHS teachers. Trish said that February 7 will be an information night for prospective EHHS students, so the PTSO meeting should be changed to a different day. There is a donation bin in the COS office for clean plastic film and bags, this collection effort is to benefit Sakai Intermediate School.
- V. Lisa Barfield, Treasurer, shared a balance sheet for 2018-2019, showing a funds balance of \$8272.22, that doesn't include anticipated expenses.
- VI. Sarah Albee said that the Barnes and Noble fundraiser only made about \$100. She is planning to set up a Sunday FUNDay fundraiser at Eleven Winery. She is hoping that EHHS PTSO can have separate a fun event for families that includes the COS marimbas. We could do another month of clothing drive, and/or coordinate with the Rotary Auction for getting clothing donations in June.
